	***** Deborah Kidd-Trammell reported flooding that occurred on the Sloans Valley Road. Specifically area near Fins and Feathers and Blue Hole. The residents had to use a row boat to get in and out of the area. There are 6 permanent residents and 13 vacation homes that were affected by the flooding. She requested road work to prevent this from happening in the future and pavement to be repaired that was damaged from this year's flooding.
