	January 9, 2024 with Marshall Todd presiding. The following Magistrates were

	Turpen Wilson Ranshaw Strunk	
	(1) Motion made by Magistrate Magistate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate	
	Ranshaw to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on December 14, 2023.	
	Motion carried.	
	(2) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Turpen to	
	enter in a Non Profit Agreement with New Life Church as a warming center. The	
	County will contribute \$1000 per month from January-March 2024. Motion carried.	
	(3) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to pay	
	the first draw to New Life Church for the month of January. Motion carried.	
	(4) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Turpen to	
	extend/ renew the lease on 3rd floor with CASA until December 31, 2026. Motion	
	carried.	
	(5) Motion made by Magistrate Turpen and seconded by Magistrate Wilson to	
	advertise for a Public Hearing to bring the 461 Connector Roads into County	
	Maintenance. The roads are listed as follows: Mark Shopville Spur (655 feet), Mark	
	Shopville Road (1,880 feet), Valley Oak Road (830 feet), Coin Road (1,350 feet),	
	Coin Road Connector (180 feet), Pin Oak Drive (1,071 feet) and Pin Oak Connector	
	(730 feet). Motion carried.	
	(6) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Turpen to	
	advertise for a Public Hearing to remove a portion of Dogwood Drive from the County	
	Maintenance System. Motion carried.	
	(7) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Wilson to accept	
	the one bid submitted for custodial supplies, from South Central Janitorial Supply.	
	Motion carried.	

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	(8) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Ranshaw for receiving the 2024 Sheriff's Budget as a whole in the amount of \$4,622,000. Motion carried.	
	(9) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to approve the annual order setting maximum salaries for deputies and assistants. Motion carried.	
	(10) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Ranshaw to allow the Sheriff's Department to participate in State Advancement Program. Motion carried.	
	(11) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Wilson to accept the 2022 local Mineral Tax Settlement and turn bills over. There was five bills in total. One was paid and four are still delinquent. Motion carried.	
	(12) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to accept the bid from FREI Mechanical in the amount of \$145,000 for a new HAVC at the Detention Center. This will come from arap monies. Motion carried.	
	(13) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to accept the bid from Central Restaurant Products in the amount of \$13,360 for a new stove top griddle for the Detention Center. These funds will come from arap monies. Motion carried.	
	(14) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to continue contract with Comprehensive Correctional Care for inmate medical services. Motion carried.	
	(15) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to stay with Kel Well Food Management with a .02 cent increase in feeding inmates. Motion carried.	
	(16) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Turpen to pay the invoice in the amount of \$44,018.78 for software upgrades on video equipment at the Detention Center. This amount will be reimbursed through the grant from the purchase of equipment. Motion carried.	

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	(17) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Ranshaw to accept a check in the amount of \$8,753.18 from the Detention Center in salary reimbursment from the inmate commissary. Motion carried.	
	(18) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to bid the lease buyouts on eight vehicles. Motion carried.	
	(19) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Wilson to surplus three vehicles from the Detention Center (Chevrolet Tahoe vin # 1GNEC13T51J251687, Chevrolet Express vin # 1GAZGNFFXH1105042 and Chevrolet Express vin # 1GAZGNFFXH103310). This surplus will also include various furniture and garage doors. Motion carried.	
	(20) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Turpen to accept the bid in the amount of \$31,105 for Dive Equipment to be purchased for the Rescue Squad. Motion carried.	
	(21) Motion made by Magistrate Ranshaw and seconded by Magistrate Strunk for receiving the 2024 County Clerk's Budget as a whole. Motion carried.	
	(22) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to approve the annual order setting maximum amount for deputies and clerks. Motion carried.	
	(23) Motion made by Magistrate Strunk and seconded by Magistrate Wilson to allow use of funds for the operation of four new cash drawers at the County Clerk's Office. Each drawer will contain \$200. Motion carried.	
	(24) Motion made by Magistrate Wilson and seconded by Magistrate Strunk to purchase 3000 ton of rock. Motion carried.
